7 acres of Jamia Al-Karam's land at Eaton Hall, Retford, Nottinghamshire, designated for the construction of Al-Karam Girls School.

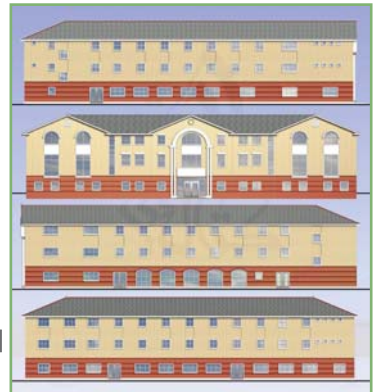
Full planning permission for the new development granted by Bassetlaw District Council, 3 August 2007.

The Al-Karam Girls School Project

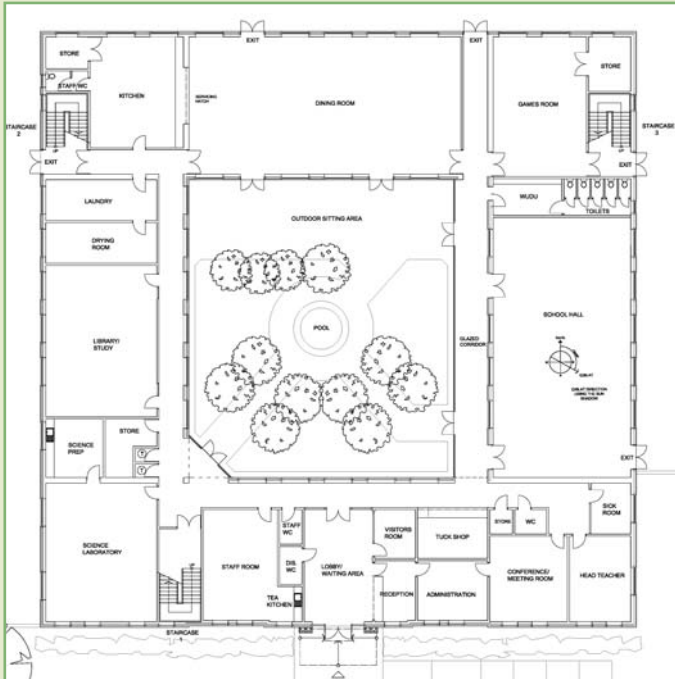

Due to this demand and need, Jamia Al-Karam has launched a new worthy project, Al-Karam Girls School, an independent boarding secondary school for girls.

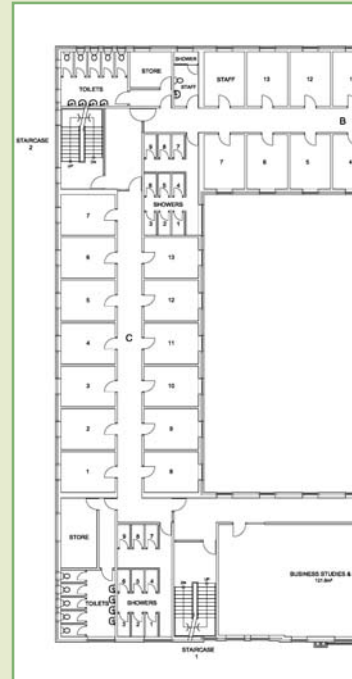

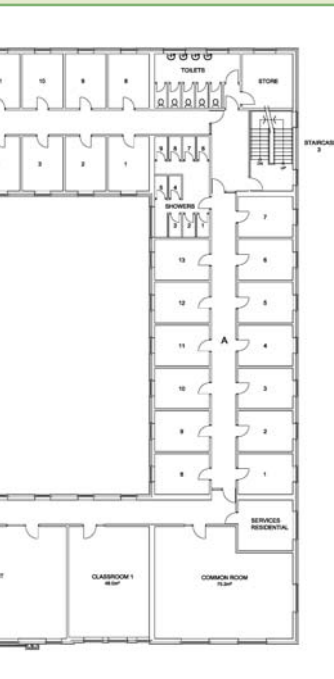
The minimum cost of the new development is **five million pounds (£5,000,000)**.

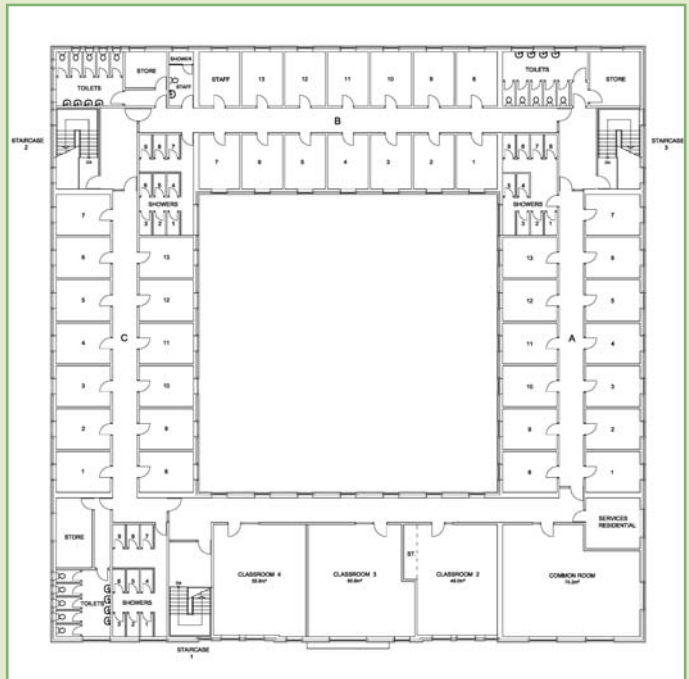
